### CEREMONIAL WELCOME OF VISTING DELEGATIONS

#### **Grand 5 & 6**

### Friday, 14 April 2023 - 5.00pm

In order to avoid the repetition of receiving Visiting Delegations at each of the two Grand Installations, it has been decided that Visiting Delegations and the Leaders/Representatives of the Other Rites will be received at a single 'Welcome Ceremony' immediately prior to the Installation of Grand Mark. This 'Welcome Ceremony' will be held at 5.00pm on Friday, 14 April 2023 and will be the ONLY time that Delegations will be received. Immediately the 'Welcome Ceremony' has concluded, the Grand Mark Installation will commence.

Members of Delegations (irrespective of rank, other than the Leader of the Delegation and DGM/DGZ, Current Second and Third Grand Principals and PGM/PGZ) and Leaders/Representatives of the Other Rites, will be seated in the Lodge Room in the regalia appropriate to their Delegation prior to the commencement of the 'Welcome Ceremony' and will occupy these same seats (as far as possible, but check the seating plan that will be on display in the foyer before entering for the Grand Chapter Installation (Saturday) – your seat may have changed.) The Leaders of Delegations and those previously mentioned will be introduced individually at the 'Welcome Ceremony' preceded by a ceremonial procession.

#### **Other Masonic Rites in Victoria**

Leaders/Representatives of the Other Rites in Victoria will be formally received and there will be an entry procession as part of the 'Welcome to Visiting Delegations.' They will occupy the same seats for ALL ceremonies.

At the 'Welcome of Visiting Delegations' the Grand Directors of Grand Mark and Supreme Grand Chapter (VWBro Terry Clifton and VEmComp Brendon Wallace) will introduce each of the Leaders/Representatives in turn. As their name is announced the Leader/Representative will go forward, shake the hands with the First Grand Principal and the Grand Master and then move off to the reserved seating in the South side of the 'Lodge Room' and be seated. When the name of the LAST Leader/Representative is announced, shaken hands and taken up his seat, ALL Leaders/Representatives will rise and observe the Sign of Fidelity. ALL will remain standing until, after the welcome by the GZ and GM and then they will be seated by the GDC.

#### **Visiting Delegations**

The Ceremonial Welcome will commence at 5.00pm. <u>ALL members of Visiting Delegations will</u> <u>be seated in the body of Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter prior to the Opening.</u> ONLY the Leader of each Delegation and DGM/DGZ, Current Second and Third Grand Principals and PGM/PGZ) will be ceremonially received. The Leader will be seated in the East.

"Most Worshipful Grand Master and Most Eminent First Grand Principal, I have the honour to introduce......" Upon introduction, each leader will move to the East and be greeted by the Most Eminent First Grand Principal and the Most Worshipful Grand Master. After the exchange of a very brief welcome, the visiting leader will then be ushered to his seat on the dais in the East and sit without direction. As the leader is introduced all members of that delegation seated in the body of the 'Lodge Room' will rise and hold the Sign of Fidelity or as appropriate for their Order. As the leader of their Order seated, delegation will their is the resume seats.

Throughout the ceremonies the Grand Directors of Ceremonies will frequently call upon Companions and Brethren to rise, sit, stand, etc. On some occasions ALL present will be asked to rise, sit, etc. Notwithstanding any instructions published in the Grand Installation Programmes, please listen for any verbal instructions given from time to time by the Grand Directors of Ceremonies.

#### Regalia

Brethren and Companions of Visiting Delegations attending both the Supreme Grand Chapter Installation and the Grand Mark Installation are to wear regalia according to their jurisdiction; all other Brethren and Companions can wear either Royal Arch or Mark regalia according the ceremony. However, you can wear Mark regalia in Grand Chapter or Chapter regalia in Grand Mark if you prefer not to over burden your regalia cases! This does not apply to members of Visiting Delegations. Members of Grand Mark and Supreme Grand Chapter Teams will wear appropriate regalia.

#### **Appearance Sheet**

Appearance Sheets (sign in sheets) have been dispensed with as this is a ticketed event in every respect.

#### **Light refreshments**

Light refreshments (afternoon tea) will be available near to the 'Lodge Room' in the hour before the commencement of each Grand Installation.

#### **Timings**

#### Friday, 14 April 2023

The 'Welcome Ceremony for Delegations and Other Rites' will commence at 5.00pm; Grand Mark will "Call On" at 6.00pm for Installation; a Cocktail Party Reception will follow the Grand Mark Installation from 8.00pm for approximately two hours.

#### Saturday, 15 April 2023

Supreme Grand Chapter will 'Call On' at 3.00pm for Installation;

Pre-dinner drinks at 6.30pm and the Grand Banquet will commence at 7.00pm and conclude at approximately 11.00pm.

#### Sunday, 16 April 2023

Farewell luncheon will be held in the 'Elements Room' at the Pullman Hotel commencing at 12.00noon and conclude by 2.00pm

#### Name badges

All Brethren/Companions are reminded to bring and wear their names badges; your wife/partner also.

#### **Neck Jewels**

Those entitled to wear neck jewels (Craft/Mark/Royal Arch/Other Rites) are to continue to wear such jewels at the Cocktail Party and the Grand Banquet.

#### Seating in Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter Room

Seating in the Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter Room is a complex issue. In order that this Information Booklet be not overburdened, a separate 'Seating in Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter Room Plan' has been prepared and will be on display in the Porch area of Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter. Broadly speaking however, specific seating will be allocated for Visiting Delegations and the Leaders of the Other Masonic Rites in the body of Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter. These same seats will apply for the Ceremonial Welcome, and Installations. Leaders of Delegations will have specific seating in the East according to the particular Installation. While a seating plan will be provided, each individual seat (in the East) will have an individual name on the seat for each ceremony. Ushers will be on hand to assist Leaders of Delegations to the right seat when they return for the resumption of Grand Chapter on the Saturday. If, on the day, you have any questions about the seating arrangements, please ask one of the ushers that will be in Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter to direct you. Seating Plans will be on display in and around the various Robing Rooms.

#### **Robing Rooms**

GM/GZs, DGMDGZs, PGM/PGZs, GH and GJ are to robe in Secretariat Rooms M7 – M10 on the first floor immediately at the head of the winding staircase. Signage will direct you to the appropriate room. All other Brethren/Companions of Visiting Delegations, Other Rites and the Brethren/Companions of Victoria will robe in the "Elements Room." If you are unsure exactly where to robe then ask one of the ushers that will be in and around Grand Lodge/Chapter. The same robing arrangements will apply for both the Friday and the Saturday. All robing areas will be secured during the ceremonies. Brethren and Companions are strongly urged to attach a name label to their case to avoid any confusion. The Elements Room (unfortunately) is not a huge area, so when you have robed please do not linger any longer than is necessary.

#### Water

Water will be provided at various points around the venue and bottle water will be available from the Information Desk. Please stay well hydrated.

#### **Medical facilities**

There is 'on site' medical assistance available within the Pullman/Mercure Hotel Complex if required. All Security Staff are fully trained in First Aid.

#### **Car Parking**

Brethren and Companions are offered a discounted car-parking rate of \$18.00 per 24 hours, per exit. A 'follow up' ticket will be available from the GSE/GSec; when leaving the car park, you will need to take both tickets to the automatic pay machine (located on B1 and B2) the original entry tickets needs to be inserted first, followed by the 'follow up' ticket to reduce the cost.

#### **Trains, Trams and Buses**

'Myki' is Melbourne's ticket to travel on the city's trains, trams and buses.

International and interstate visitors coming to Victoria can buy full fare or concession myki Visitor Pack from the Melbourne Visitor Centre at Federation Square or from the PTV Hub at Southern Cross Station, near the corner of Spencer and Collins Streets or ask at your hotel. For 'the better elucidation of the secrets' of the Melbourne Public Transport System, contact the PTV website.

The City Circle Tram is a free service within Melbourne's CBD. The service operates in a circular route passing all major tourist attractions. Trams run every twelve minutes between 10.00am and 6.00pm Sunday to Wednesday and 10.00am to 9.00pm Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Contact for Public Transport Victoria: 1800 800 007

#### **Greetings from Visiting Delegations – Ceremonial Welcome**

MWBro Dr Boo Khean Khoo, GM (GLMMM SEA) and MExComp Andrew Lockyer, GZ (SA&NT) will acknowledge Grand Honours and offer greetings on behalf of ALL Visiting Delegations and the Leaders/Representatives of the Other Rites in Victoria.

#### **Greetings from Visiting Delegations – Installation**

At the conclusion of the Supreme Grand Chapter Installation, greetings and congratulations will be received from MExComp Ian Hodgson, GZ (Queensland) on behalf of ALL Other Rites and Visiting Delegations.

At the conclusion of the Grand Mark Installation, greetings and congratulations will be received from MWBro Paul Southon, GM (Grand Mark Queensland) on behalf of ALL Other Rites and Visiting Delegations.

Members of ALL Visiting Delegations and the Leaders/Representatives of the Other Rites in Victoria will rise and observe the Sign of Fidelity on each occasion. At the conclusion of the greetings the respective GDC will seat all with the Sign of Fidelity.

#### **Grand Honours**

At various times during the course of the Ceremonies of Grand Installation, Members of Delegations will be called upon to render Grand Honours. The Honours so given are according to the apron you are wearing and the jurisdiction to which you belong. When you are called on to give Grand Honours, you will rise, face the Grand Master/First Grand Principal, (DGZ etc, etc) and give the appropriate Grand Honours:

#### After Installation of Grand Master/First Grand Principal

A Grand Master/First Grand Principal (or Companion/Brother of equal rank) greets with Grand Honours the newly Installed First Grand Principal or Grand Master.

Companions/Brethren of lower rank will accord Grand Honours. (9 times)

#### After Installation of Deputy Grand Master/Deputy First Grand Principal

A Companion/Brother of equal rank greets with Grand Honours the newly Installed Deputy Grand Master/Deputy First Grand Principal.

Companions/Brethren of a lower rank will accord Grand Honours. (7 times)

#### After Installation of Second and Third Grand Principals

A Companion/Brother of equal rank greets with Grand Honours the newly installed Second and Third Grand Principals.

Companions/Brethren (SGW and below) of a lower rank will accord Grand Honours. (7 times)

#### <u>After Investiture of Grand Officers</u>

All Members of Delegations will remain seated.
